# School Context

Emmanuel Christian School is a growing Kindergarten to Year 10 Christian school located in the Hobart suburb of Rokeby in the heart of the Clarence Plains community. We are one of four schools governed by the Board of Christian Schools Tasmania.

At Emmanuel, we have teachers who have a variety of pedagogical approaches that have the common goal of providing the highest quality education in a nurturing and supportive Christian environment.

Our enrolment in 2021 reached 239 students.

# **Teacher Qualifications**


